Chaplain's Corner

FINALLY the elections are over ... but for all the complaining about the negative ads, there seems to be no end to the continuing negative comments and conversations from all sides on the results of the elections. On this matter, I wish to offer some points for our mutual consideration, and here I am helped by my colleague, Rev. Graham Hart, Exec. Presbyter of Peace River Presbytery.

"There are shrill voices out there telling us that the only way to move forward is to be loud, disrespectful, and angry. If it is more acceptable to demonize someone with whom we disagree or to refuse to work together, we are on a path that will make it difficult for future generations to work on solutions because we will have created an environment of fear, disrespect, and anger."

As people of faith here at Bay Village we "... can be the one place to set a different tone, and offer a different way to still be one nation, under God, even when we disagree as to the solutions to these complex issues."

My encouragement and prayer is for us "to disagree without being disagreeable; to love our neighbor, even when the neighbor voted differently; to come together on tough issues that may evoke different responses."

May we at Bay Village continue to be living testimonies that, under God, all people—even "red and blue"—are more than welcome here to live a deep and respectful life which honors all.
