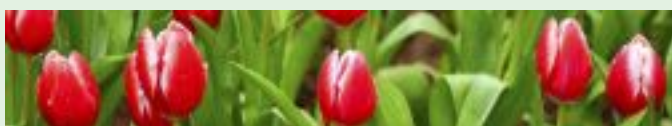

## April 2014

### All About Easter

Easter, one of the most important holidays in Christianity, celebrates the central event of the Christian faith: the resurrection of Jesus Christ after his crucifixion. This event is significant to Christians because, through his death and resurrection, Jesus suffered for the sins of the world, yet was able to overcome death.

Easter is observed on the first Sunday after the full moon that occurs on or after the vernal equinox (the first day of spring). According to the Bible, the events of the crucifixion and resurrection occurred during the Jewish Passover, a springtime celebration.

Easter is preceded by Lent, a 40-day period of fasting and repentance that begins on Ash Wednesday. The Sunday before Easter is Palm Sunday, the day that Jesus arrived in Jerusalem. The week before Easter is called Holy Week.

During Holy Week, Christians observe Maundy Thursday, when the Last Supper with Jesus and his disciples took place; and Good Friday, the day of the crucifixion. The resurrection is then celebrated on Easter Sunday.

At Bay Village, we will hold our annual Good Friday communion at our vespers service on Friday, April 18, at 3:30 p.m. On Easter morning, join us for our annual sunrise service on the rooftop terrace at 7:30 a.m. Light refreshments will be served following the service.

Easter dinner reservations can be made by calling Ehsan at ext. 2113. Dinner seating times are at noon, 2 and 4 p.m. Happy Easter, everyone!

### Chaplain's Corner

No matter what you might think, it is not too late. You have not lost your chance for reflection and renewal. In fact, the world is crying out for each of us to do just that. Our world's existence depends on our commitment to help establish a world community based on justice, respect, humility and grace. The cynic will disregard all that as being naive, but in the privacy of our souls each of us knows those are the only answers. Throughout the year, each of the three main religions focus on the need for renewal: Judaism= Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur; Christianity=Lent; Islam=Ramadan. There still is time for each of us to be renewed. How? A recent email offers some reflection:

Give up PRIDE - "blessed are the humble," so all will be blessed.

Give up BLAME - take responsibility for your own actions, and be part of the solution.

Give up GUILT - Each of us is a beloved child of God. Today is a gift of new day.

Give up ENTITLEMENT - No one, not even God, owes me anything. I live only by grace.

Give up FEAR OF FAILURE - failure is part of success ... just make sure to fail forward.

Give up UNWORTHINESS - each person is fearfully and wonderfully made by God.

Give us FEAR - nothing ... NOTHING ... can separate you from the love of God.

Thank you, Marian Wissenberg, for reminding us renewal is not just for a season, but a lifetime journey of re-creation.
