Identifying America

At home or abroad, most people can name a symbol that represents the United States to them. Americans have no shortage of national icons, and here's some information on a few of the most famous:

Lady Liberty. The first thing seen by many as they reach America, the Statue of Liberty was a gift from France. Originally intended to be presented in 1876 to commemorate a century of American independence, France offered to pay for the statue, while the U.S. agreed to pay for the pedestal. Lack of funds in both countries led to a 10-year delay in the statue's dedication, which took place in 1886.

Old Glory. Possibly the most recognized flag in the world, creation of the first version has long been attributed to Betsy Ross. Between 1777 and 1960, various acts and executive orders changed the shape, design and arrangement of the original flag. The colors (red, white and blue) and stars and stripes have been elements in each version.

Beautiful bird. Thanks in part to its great strength and stately looks, Congress chose the bald eagle as the national symbol in 1782. However, not all founding fathers agreed with the choice—Benjamin Franklin insisted the wild turkey would be the better bird for such an honor.

To celebrate America's independence, Bay Village will hold its annual *Independence Day Picnic* on **July 4** and we will also enjoy a *patriotic concert* that evening by fantastic *jazz pianist Mike Markaverich* at **7:30 p.m.** in the auditorium!

Chaplain's Corner
Rev. Dr. Chuck Moffett

As many of you would expect, this July column will focus on **FREEDOM**. I affirm our gratitude for all of God's blessings to us for the many ways in which we thrive in a culture of freedom. However, let us not give in to the danger of a limited type of thinking that can lead us to assume:

- we are better than everyone else in the world;*
- America is a Christian nation deserving divine protection;*
- non-Americans/non-Christians are outside of God's grace.*

I invite us to consider that this type of thinking is at the core of the distrust - and even hostility - across the aisles of our politicians, and across the aisles of our hallways and conversations. If our definition of freedom is limited to *our* values, *our* faith, *our* life style, *our* understanding of God, then we become vulnerable to the viewpoints which created the likes of the Holocaust, and continue in the forms of the current hate crimes, and our own bigotry against anyone who is not like "us."

I invite us to consider happenings in Crimea, Pakistan, North Korea, Sudan, Brazil, Iran, Florida - to name a few - where freedom is being defined on a most limited scope.

Then I encourage us to place those limited definitions alongside the true meaning of our American belief: **"All (people) are created equal;"** ...and what the Christian Scripture states: **"There is no longer Jew or Greek, slave or free, male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus."**

On July 4, and every day, may we be intentional advocates for freedom for all of God's children everywhere in the world - not just for us. Thank God for the gift of grace offered to us, which we are to share with EVERYONE.
