During her tenure with the orchestra, she was featured as a soloist on Mozart's flute and harp concerto.

Ms. Ciarla's chamber music activities have included performances with many artists of international acclaim.

Additional performances have included the Prague Symphony, Orchestra of Slovacchia, Festival Pucciniano di Torre del Lago,

Smithsonian Institute's Axelrod String Quartet, Santa Fe Pro Musica and appearances at both the International Jazz and Pop Harp Festival in Monterey, California and the Umbria Jazz Festival in Perugia, Italy.

Ms. Ciarla holds degrees from the Conservatorio Lorenzo Perosi in Italy and the University of Arizona. She has recorded for Bongiovanni and Koch record labels.
